The 2010 IMCA Speedway Motors Super Nationals begins full throttle and remains on the gas through the Modified Championship on Saturday night. The opening night of America's Racin' Vacation is highlighted by the annual Labor Day running of the Deery Brothers Summer Series. IMCA Late Models thunder into Boone with a 50-lap scramble to crown the first of five champions. While the Late Model program is the headliner, the best IMCA Sunoco Hobby Stock and Karl Chevrolet Northern SportMod drivers in the country fight for their right to race on the weekend. The inside and middle rows of 10 for Hobby Stocks and inside row of 10 for SportMods will earn their position tonight, and both formats will determine who sits on the coveted pole position for Saturday's big dance.

SportMod drivers will also make their best attempt to qualify for the Arnold Motor Supply Race of Champions to cap the nation's busiest night of racing with 70 checkered flags.
